ACTION ITEMS

1. **CONNECT WITH US FOR UPDATES:** Sign up for Save Our States emails and follow us on Facebook.

3. **EXPOSE NPV LOBBYING:** Ask about legislators taking NPV junkets and tip off conservative media.

TALKING POINTS

HOW DOES NPV WORK? NPV is state legislation to join an agreement with other states (an "interstate compact"). These states agree to ignore their state popular vote and instead appoint their state's presidential electors based on the national popular vote.

WHY IS NPV DANGEROUS? A direct election for President would give big cities even more political power, give the federal government more control over elections, and create new opportunities for fraud. It would also encourage regionalism and allow a candidate to win with a small plurality.

WHO'S BEHIND NPV? John Koza invented the scratch-off lottery ticket and spends his winnings on far-left politics. After Al Gore's loss in 2000, Koza launched the NPV campaign to get rid of the Electoral College. George Soros's network of organizations and his son, Jonathan Soros, are major supporters of NPV.

IS NPV LEGAL? Probably not, but don't put your faith in judges to strike it down. NPV attempts to frustrate the original intent of the Electoral College and claims not to need the consent of Congress. But no one can sue until NPV takes effect, and judges are often reluctant to change election rules.

DOES NPV CREATE A "NATIONAL POPULAR VOTE"? No. NPV relies on each state certifying national vote totals, forcing states to trust, with no way to verify, the accuracy and fairness of every other state's elections. NPV fails to include provisions for recounts, administrative failures, or fraud, leaving every dispute to judges.
