- **Resist the desexing of society** in language and in law.
- **Re-localize education.** Cut ties with federal education programs.
- **Reconsider phone use in children.** Teach phone safety; restrict & monitor phone use.
- **Run for office** locally or nationally.

- **Bring back chastity.** Have children and raise them to be virtuous people who value the family and consider motherhood and fatherhood necessary, noble positions.
- **Contribute to the narrative that mothers and fathers are vital** to their children's well-being. Do this through social media, blogging, articles, conversation, etc.
- **Never give up!** The family is invincible in its design, irreplaceable in its effects, and everlasting in its position. Claim, exercise, and defend your parental rights. Remember, the family wins!
