Title: *Give Me Liberty: How Do We Protect Our Religious Liberties?*

Action points:

1. Be informed on the latest news in the religious freedom space by joining our [Liberty Watch newsletter](#).
2. Help us get the word out about First Liberty by talking with friends or by [inviting us to speak](#) to a group such as a small house gathering, a local conservative group, or a weekend service at your church.
3. Read through the Amendments in the United States Constitution to know your rights. As Supreme Court Justice John Roberts once said “You cannot fight for your rights if you do not know what those rights are.”
4. Request a [protection kit](#) that is custom tailored to help you understand your religious rights in each area of society.
5. Ensure that your state passed a constitutional amendment protecting houses of worship against future “states of emergency” such as the one [Texas passed in 2021](#). If no such protection exists, write to your elected officials and ask them to propose such an amendment.
6. Be on the lookout for deceptively named bills that use gender or LGBTQ protections to try and undercut religious liberty. See: [Respect for Marriage Act](#) and the [Equality Act](#). Contact your senators to oppose such bills when they arise.
