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BUILDING AN ARIZONA RESCUE MISSION STRATEGY

PHASE 1

Use the Legislative Cycle Wins to Build Grassroots Infrastructure for Election Cycle Wins.
(This applies to every level of government.)

Identify Target Precincts in Your Districts

Swing precincts in Swing Districts is the battleground in both the legislative and election cycles.

Survey 100 - 1000 Voters to Identify Top Issues

Let the voter conversations inform you what the legislative policy strategy should be. Inform legislative allies!

Calculate the Cycle over Cycle Voter Turnout

The cycle over cycle voter turnout may tell you if your ideology has momentum with the voters or not. Keep in mind other factors will impact this. That's why you need to do voter contact.

Legislate. Message. Repeat.

Work with your legislative partners to lead on policy the voters informed you they care about. As you achieve wins, let them know!

1. Empower the Grassroots to Become the Chief Stakeholder of their Government.
2. Recruit & train pro-freedom voters neighborhood-by-neighborhood in targeted districts with the voter contact to Meet & Greet Cycle.
3. Keep it fun & easy. Serve pie & coffee.

MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD AZ LEGISLATURE: BILLS TO KILL

The bills below either kill our freedom, create irresponsible government spending, or violate important Constitutional protections. They are scheduled to be heard in Committees mentioned below.

Bill Number	Committee	Description	House	Appropriation	Time
SB1702	Striker - Livingston	This bill possibly violates the Single Subject Rule. It turns planning and authority over to regional governing committees, which are unelected governing boards. SB1702 places a 20 year tax on transit and also changes zoning regulations to implement such agencies that will make Maricopa go broke.	House	Appropriation 1 - HOUSE 1	4/3 10 AM
SB1294	Striker - Quinones	Increases tax credits from \$500,000 to \$100,000 to give the government more money for tax income housing. This is the wrong way to handle this issue.	House	Appropriation 1 - HOUSE 1	4/3 10 AM
SB1225	Striker - Livingston	Takes current tobacco regulations and unfree them through state law, increases the age of tobacco use to 21, and makes the tobacco retail companies file with a state agency instead of city or county.	House	Appropriation 1 - HOUSE 1	4/3 10 AM
HB2543	Dunn	The Legislature is allowing COGs and HPOs to create policy and ordinances on how our tax dollars are going to be spent. COGs and HPOs are unelected organizations of governance whose ideas and friends are getting paid over \$31 million through this bill. The bill has no oversight of how the money is to be spent and could be funding racialist left, woke agendas. The only way to know where the money is being spent is by seeing the submissions from these unelected organizations.	Senate	Appropriation 1 - SENATE 109	4/4 1 PM

SB7001	CARDOL	One of the most important bills of the session to stop the waste takeover of retirement funds. Requires the state treasurer post online a list of state investments. Requires investments be determined solely on the basis of beneficiaries — meaning that vote companies can't be prioritized for political reasons. Politically investments in funds that invest based on woke priorities.	Senate	Government 219	9:30 A.M.
SB1201	FABRIZIO	Flares our roads by requiring local governments spend vehicle license tax revenues on transportation related expenses. Currently, local governments can spend this transportation tax revenue on ANYTHING they want.	Senate	Transportation and Technology 219	2:00 P.M.
HB2011	CHARLES	Protects individual liberty and helps stop social credit scoring from determining if you can buy goods and services by requiring businesses with a physical location allowing business to permit to accept cash as a form of payment. Cash transactions are important to protect the unbanked.	House	Commerce 217	2:00 P.M.
SB1710	HOFMAN	Protects the freedom of movement by prohibiting government from monitoring how many miles you drive, prohibiting any monitoring of your movements, limiting how much you can travel, or taxing travel mileage.	Senate	Transportation and Technology 219	2:00 P.M.
SB1701	KASER	Prohibits a person from a bond overrule from then bidding on the contract funded by the new law if it's passed.	Senate	Education 219	2:00 P.M.
SB1200	MESABOD	Accelerates the reduction of the Arizona small business income tax rate to 2.5 percent by two legislative years.	Senate	Finance 219	2:00 P.M.
SB1099	MESABOD	Creates accountability to government K-12 funding by requiring school districts to give their budget online.	Senate	Education 219	2:00 P.M.
HB1224	RODRIGUEZ	Prohibits photo radar traffic enforcement. Photo radar is dangerous and also a violation of the Constitution.	House	Government 219	2:00 P.M.
SB1710	FABRIZIO	This bill is a new version of the Maricopa County transportation tax which will increase the tax. It's a bad idea because it's funded on transportation projects and the revenue of the state. This new bill flies these issues and requires a vote from the voters on election day.	Senate	Transportation and Technology 219	2:00 P.M.
SB1201	SHARP	Medical freedom bill that requires employers to accept a religious exemption for vaccination.	Senate	Health and Human Services 217	2:00 P.M.
HB2541	JONES	Provides for more accountability to K-12 by requiring school districts with more than 10,000 students hold an election to allow the voters to decide if the district should be broken up into smaller districts. The problem the district, the more accountability to parents.	House	Municipal Government & Directors 219	2:00 P.M.

WHAT ARE REGIONAL COUNCILS?



Regional councils, also known as councils of governments and regional commissions, are public organizations comprised of local elected officials that promote collaboration among local governments, working across the jurisdictional silos of states, counties, and municipalities.

COUNCILS OF GOVERNMENTS:

- REGIONAL UNELECTED NON-PROFITS
- BYPASS THE PEOPLE
- OFTEN WORK IN COORDINATION WITH LOBBYISTS TO DIRECT STATE LEGISLATURES/LOCAL GOVT TO CHANGE LAWS TO ACCOMMODATE FEDERAL SPENDING COERCION.

Regional Councils of Government exist in every state. Started in 1960 under a government program called "Coercive Federalism." Massively increases Federal spending to funnel money to local government with hostile strings to neutralize state rights. Most WEF policies come through this mechanism or Associations.
