SB1146	Hoffman	Requires the State Board of Investment (BOI) to identify U.S. companies that donate to or invest in organizations that promote abortions for minors or sexually explicit material in grades K-12. Requires the State Treasurer to divest from the identified companies.	House Govt	3/15 9am
SB1696	Hoffman	Prohibits an office, board or commission or political subdivision, or their contractors, from exposing minors to sexually explicit materials. Classifies a sexually explicit material violation as a class 5 felony.	House Govt	3/15 9am

SB1074	Borelli	Requires that all electronic voting equipment have all parts manufactured in the US and a meet Dept of Defense cyber security standard. Requires the Auditor General to store all source codes and includes provisions for it to be reviewed.	House MOE	3/15 2pm
SB1565	Carroll	Prohibits use of machines, devices, firmware or software from containing artificial intelligence or learning software, firmware, or hardware for use in elections.	House MOE	3/15 2pm
SB1596	Mesnard	Requires a state, county, city, town or school district office to provide sufficient space for use as a polling place for an election when requested by the officer in charge of elections. Appropriates \$10M.	House MOE	3/15 2pm
SB1243	Mesnard	Increases the annual cap on the School Tuition Organizations tax credit from \$655 to \$1,456 for a single and from \$1,308 to \$2,902 for a married couple	House W&M	3/15 9am

HB2332	Bliss	Requires schools provide firearm safety training. Does not include training on how to use a firearm.	Senate Ed	3/15 2pm
